

ATTENTION STUDENTS RESIDING AT THE CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL

Concerning your right to vote at the election on November 3rd to elect our next Governor.



State law requires that you must be registered in the same county in which you live in order to vote. Students residing at school may wish to register using their on campus or off campus residence.

Since the Crowne Plaza hotel is located in Somerset County any student who is currently living here, and wishes to vote from this address, must be registered in Somerset County to be able to vote in November.

If you previously registered at another address, either on campus or off campus, but you wish to vote from here, you need to check and update your voter record on or before October 13th.
